What is the purpose of the Community Conversation?

Mercy Ministries Slaton Area Endowment and the Lubbock Area Foundation have embarked on a collaborative effort to identify the region's best opportunities and most pressing needs, and to set bold goals to achieve over the coming years. This Community Conversation is one step in that endeavor.

As an earlier step, the Endowment and Foundation commissioned a **Community Needs and Opportunities** assessment of Slaton. This brief report profiles some **key data and trends** about the community's people, economy and resources. It also details an estimate of the **huge transfer of wealth** that will be passing from generation to generation in our community over the next 10 years, a portion of which we might want to invest in building a better community. Finally, it includes the results of a **Summer 2014 survey** that asked Slaton residents what they like about living here – and what they would improve.

This Community Conversation will present the results of this assessment, and ask participants to reflect on what they hear in the presentations and see in the report. Mercy Ministries Slaton Area Endowment plans to examine the priorities that emerge from this Conversation and other such conversations in the community. These priorities will help shape the work of the Endowment – both its grantmaking and convening, as well as its aspirations and plans for growing and investing more local resources to build a better future for our community.
